A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING LAWRENCE COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, AND ENTER INTO A WATER POLLUTION CONTROL LOAN FUND AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE COUNTY/HEALTH DISTRICT OF LAWRENCE COUNTY FOR THE REPAIR AND REPLACEMENT OF HOME SEWAGE TREATMENT SYSTEMS:

Whereas, the Health District of Lawrence County seeks to repair and/or replace failing home sewage treatment systems; and

Whereas, the Health District of Lawrence County intends to apply to the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) for the repair and/or replacement of failing home sewage treatment systems; and

Whereas, the Ohio Water Pollution Control Loan Fund requires the government authority to pass legislation for application of a loan and the execution of a WPCLF assistance agreement; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of the Health District of Lawrence County, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Georgia Dillon, Health Commissioner, be and is hereby authorized to apply for a WPCLF assistance agreement, sign all documents for and enter into a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency for the repair and/or replacement of failing home sewage treatment systems on behalf of the Health District of Lawrence County, Ohio.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
